Holkham Farming Company

Today, a total of 3500 hectares of estate land are managed by Holkham Farming Company Ltd which was set up in 1996 to act as a contractor for the In-hand farms which cover 2300 hectares of arable land. The remainder of the land is under Agri-environment, game crops and grassland. Holkham Farming Company has full management and operational responsibilities for all arable activities, livestock, grain storage and contract work for two anaerobic digesters. Holkham is also a 50% partner in an award-winning potato enterprise specialising in salad potatoes.

Holkham Emerald

Holkham Emerald are a specialist potato grower based on the Estate that was formed in 2009. The businesses have gone from strength to strength and today grows approximately 400 hectares of produce annually with cropping split into salad, ware, processing and seed potato production. The business supplies multiple UK and export markets and has storage and grading facilities on site. Four years ago, the company took back control of all operations and employs a core team of 8 that expands to 25 at peak periods.

Overall Job Purpose

The Holkham Estate has invested in an industry-leading workshop facility and 6500 tonne potato store with modern equipment located at Egmere, Walsingham. The workshop is shared by the two farming businesses on the estate, Holkham Farming Company and Holkham Emerald. The role would entail overseeing the maintenance and repair of both businesses' equipment, which uses leading brands such as John Deere, JCB, Grimme, and Vaderstad.

The candidate would create work plans and timeframes for team members to ensure that machines are overhauled promptly. The position would also command the responsibility of procuring parts, consumables and sundries.

Regular servicing and maintenance of equipment will be required as well as immediate repairs when necessary. The candidate would ensure that the workshop is clean, tidy, and a safe working environment and would take the lead on enforcing the site's strict health and safety policy.

Key Responsibilities

- Maintenance and repair of farm machinery.
- Management of the Egmere site and workshop. Ensuring site is tidy and standards are kept.
- Lead on-site Health and Safety liaising with the third-party Health and Safety consultant.
- Scheduling of works through workshop.
- Procurement of consumables, parts and sundries.
- Accurate recording for each job so that jobs can be invoiced out accurately.
- Ensuring risk assessments are up to date and are adhered to
- To represent HFC at all times and positively manage relationships with the community.
- To ensure you adhere to HFC processes and that you act within the Holkham behaviours at all times
- Any other duties that may be required. This is flexible role that will often involve duties not listed above.
